The bids will then and there be publicly opened and read aloud. Any bids received after the published bid submittal time cannot be considered and will not be accepted by the Port.

The Work includes:

All labor, materials, tools, equipment, permits, testing, training, and supervision for the installation of all components of the Port of Kalama T-Barge Pontoon Modification project as shown in the plans and specifications, generally including:

- Furnish and install watertight bulkheads in the existing barge,
- Furnish and install bullrail, fenders, ladders, spud wells, pedestal crane base, doors, etc.,
- Surface prep and application of new painted coatings,
- Barge transportation, installation and ballasting,
- Furnish and install new spud piles,
- Furnish and install gangway landing platform and coordinate gangway placement (phase 1 contractor),
- Install, test and certify owner furnished crane,
- Furnish and install new electrical power and lighting systems on refurbished barge

All contractors MUST comply with the prevailing wage and anti-discrimination laws of the State of Washington, and pay all associated fees. The Port of Kalama will comply with the statutory retainage requirements for public works contracts. The Port of Kalama is an equal opportunity employer.
